



HANGING INSTRUCTIONS FOR DOUBLE WHITE MOSQUITO NET



INSTRUCTIONS

Your mosquito net is equipped with 8 (eight) loops - One on each corner and one in the middle of the net's width and length. These loops are used to suspend your mosquito net correctly. Should you wish to have less hanging points, using 4 or 6 loops will suffice.

1. Prepare 4, 6, or 8 hooks - the ones with a loop are preferred.
2. If you drill into a wall, use wall plugs.
3. The bottom edge of the net should just touch the floor, preventing mosquitoes from entering.
4. The height of your net is 200 cm, therefore we suggest that you measure the height of the holes that you created in the walls at 210 cm from the floor. Thus allowing for the ropes to be at an angle to suspend the net (step 5).
5. To keep the roof as flat as possible we suggest the hooks and thus the ropes for each corner be at a slight angle, allowing you to tighten the net securely to avoid sagging.

Washing your net - If you decide to wash your net, it is best to place it in a washing bag to protect the fabric. Use a very small amount of detergent and wash at a temperature lower than 40 degrees C (or < 104 degrees F).
